

From Helmets to Hardhats:

Connecting former and active duty military service members to careers in highway maintenance. Temporary Highway Maintenance and Highway Technician positions are available throughout the year in District 6.

This program offers opportunities for:

- Temporary employment for up to six months as a Highway
 Maintenance Worker 1 or Highway Technician 1
- The opportunity for serious consideration for other temporary and permanent Highway Technician 1 opportunities after completion of the Veteran Apprentice Program
- Specialized training to obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) for those who have not obtained a CDL prior
- Reimbursement for first-time cost associated with obtaining a CDL
- Advancement to Highway Technician 1 position for those who have already obtained a CDL
- Training in equipment operations, safety practices, highway maintenance, and snow & ice removal
- Partnership with an ODOT mentor

Positions start at \$15.60/hour

Qualifications:

- 18 years of age
- A valid driver's license
- Formal education in arithmetic (including addition & subtraction), reading, writing, and speaking common English vocabulary
- Potential Highway Technician 1's (who currently have a CDL) are required to have three months heavy equipment experience or commercial truck experience
