At Legal Aid clinics, you will need to answer questions about income (must have *total gross* household income at or below 250% Federal Poverty Level--\$5,125 for a household of 4) and assets (\$24,180 limit) and should bring proof of your immigration status (green card or I-94 if a non-citizen). **If you need legal help *other than advice*, contact the Legal Aid Society of Columbus at 614-224-8374.**
