CMHA Subsidized Housing

What are the different types of Subsidized housing and how do I apply?

1. HCV

- What is HCV?
 - Housing Choice Voucher allows families to rent from the private market. CMHA pays a
 housing subsidy, which is a portion of your rent based on your household income, to the
 landlord, and you are responsible for the remaining rent.
- How do I apply?
 - Go to https://app.cmhanet.com/
 - Create Account
 - Fill out Application
 - You are then added to system
 - Once an application has been submitted, an applicant can check on the status of the application by calling the automated status line at 614-421-6180
 - Applications will be added to the HCV applications pool and will be selected for the waitlist by a lottery process.
 - Applications will NOT be preferenced by the date and time of an application
 - In order for CMHA to contact you if your application is pulled, be sure to keep your information up to date within your online account.

2. Public Housing

- CMHA administers the public housing program via various properties we own but are operated by various management companies.
- How do I apply?
 - You must fill out an application at the community of interest, which will place you on the wait list.

3. PBV

- What is PBV?
 - Project Based Vouchers require tenants to pay 30% of their income towards rent.
 However, whereas the HCV subsidy is tied to the tenant, the Project-Based Voucher is attached to a designated unit.
